With the help of our trained social worker, counselors and volunteers, these teenagers open their minds to new ideas and new perspectives.

Coming from diverse backgrounds and different communities, Anytown delegates examine the causes of bias, bigotry and all forms of discrimination while building their own ideal community.

Through experiential activities, workshops, role plays, thought provoking discussions and more, Anytown challenges delegates to first imagine and then create an community based on inclusion, respect and understanding. The 2018 class of delegates represents our 16th Anytown year!

WE OFFER DELEGATES FULL SCHOLARSHIPS!!

There is a non-refundable \$25 registration fee due with the application.

We offer full scholarships to delegates who receives free or reduced lunch. For anyone else, Anytown is \$150 for this life changing opportunity.

The total cost of Anytown is \$500 per delegate. We are proud of the fact that we offer scholarships to all of our applicants to keep Anytown accessible to interested youth.
